



The Gates Mills median walking/biking trail. This proposed trail has been described at various meetings and in documents posted on the City website <http://www.pepperpike.org/2273/PEPPER-PIKE-MULTI-PURPOSE-Trail>. While this project is directed at improved walkability, it has significant differences when compared to traditional sidewalks: (1) it is in the Gates Mills median strip, (2) it will be wider than a typical sidewalk, and (3) it will be extensively landscaped. If we receive partial grant funding of \$500,000 from the state and do not receive any other grants, the cost to the City of this project would be between \$500,000 and \$700,000. 
Sidewalks along major roads. This walkability project would place a traditional concrete sidewalk along one side of sections of or the length of major roads in the City. There is no existing plan to build sidewalks and thus there are many questions that will need to be answered. But for the conceptual purposes of this survey, we will assume major roads include initially Lander, South Woodland, Shaker and Fairmount. Also assume, the City will pay for installation and maintenance (no assessment). The City may choose to first build a sidewalk on a substantial portion of one major street, as a test, and if it is successful in terms of both cost and use by our citizens then proceed with other sidewalks as resources permit. As an example, a sidewalk along one side of Lander from Shaker/Lander intersection to Chagrin/Lander circle would cost approximately \$600,000.00. Do you favor pursuing sidewalks on major streets:




